As March rapidly approaches, so does the season of Lent. March 6 will mark the arrival of Lent with Ash Wednesday and we will gather for a soup supper at 6pm, followed by a worship service starting at 6:30.

The season of Lent is a powerful

time for us as followers of Jesus. It is a more reflective season of the church year and gives us an opportunity to walk with Jesus through his sacrifice as he gave up his life to forgive us and redeem us from our sins. Lent allows us to sit with the weight of Christ's love upon each of our hearts.

This year as we do that, you are invited to join us in a campaign of Love and Kindness in Lent. In our worship services, we will explore ways to show more love and kindness to each other, to our neighbors and friends, and to our larger community. It seems like a good time to be even more intentional about sharing love and kindness in the world.

Pastor's Corner (cont'd)


Each Sunday morning, we will highlight acts of love and kindness that we observe in our Scripture readings as well as acts of love and kindness that we see in the world around us, things that others have done for us and what we do for others. You will actually have the chance to write down one thing each week and post it on the cross as a way to offer your love and kindness to Jesus, or to give thanks for what someone has done for you.

During our mid-week services on Wednesday nights (soup at 6pm and service at 6:30pm), we will continue to explore Love and Kindness in Lent as we hear "Love Letters" inspired by those who knew Jesus best as they witness the last days of his life. Each letter will help us go deeper as we explore what really is at the heart of love.

We will also have an opportunity to get started with our Love and Kindness in Lent campaign on Sunday, March 10 after both of the services. In the fellowship hall, we will be having a rock painting party. You don't need to be artistic at all. We will have all of the supplies you need to decorate a plain ordinary rock, and you can color it and make it cheery, you can write a word of encouragement on it, you can make designs or patterns on it...whatever! Once they are dry, we will seal them and then hopefully have enough for everyone to take one and leave it on a walking path, at a park, on your neighbor's porch, or wherever it will spread some Love and Kindness.

Lent is 40 days long, so I am expecting other ideas will crop up of ways that we together can share Love and Kindness in Lent. I look forward to hearing them!

Michael L Torry suddenly passed away February 21, 2019, he was born in Palo Alto California, July 14, 1942.

He is survived by his wife of 50 years, Diane and their daughters Katharine Torry, Natalie Tegio, son-in-law Russell Tegio, grandchildren Torry and Michael Tegio, mother in law Adeline Bergeson, brothers and sisters in law, nieces and nephews and a life time of friends.

He was predeceased by his father, John Torry, mother, Jere Alspaw, step father Ralph Alspaw and father in law Burnett Bergeson.

Mike graduated from McClatchy High School, Sacramento, California and a Police Academy. He served as a deputy sheriff and coroner for El Dorado County, California, management in the credit reporting industry and in 1979 opened MLT & Associates, a national credit card equipment repair company. Mike sold his business in 2008 and retired.

A lifetime boater, Mike enjoyed sail and power boating with family and friends in the San Francisco Bay, Lake Tahoe and the California Delta. In later years he turned to "boating on land" with his classic car, the "candy apple red" 1960 Pontiac Bonneville. He delighted in demonstrating for his grandchildren how you "punch it".

Mark your calendar and make your reservations! Seder Dinner is April 18th at HCLC!

On April 18th, 2018, Holy Cross Lutheran Church will be celebrating Passover during Holy Week by hosting a Seder meal. It is based on the traditional Jewish celebration of Passover, but adapted into a uniquely Christian celebration. This reminds us that God did not begin his revelation of himself in the world with Christians, but to Hebrews, to Israelites, to Jewish people first. It also reminds us that Jesus was not a Christian, but a Jew. It is only in recognizing the connection we have, to four thousand years of God at work creating a people, that we can truly appreciate who we are as people of God.

While this is a traditional Jewish celebration, it is also a Christian festival. Matthew, Mark, and Luke tell us that it was at a Passover meal that Jesus inaugurated what became known to Christians as the Lord's Supper, Communion, or Eucharist. It is also a time to retell the experience of the people of God and their deliverance out of slavery into the promised land, and to pass that history to our children. This service is a sacred time of worship, and though it follows a specific order, it is not formal. In Judaism, Passover is celebrated as a family meal. The father and mother, or grandparents, lead the service, and it is much more of a celebration than anything solemn. So, relax and have fun with the worship and meal as part of your extended family at Holy Cross Lutheran!

Tickets are available for purchase Sundays, starting on *March 17th*, between services, and reservations are required. Adults tickets are \$12 each (12 years old and up) and youth tickets are \$8 each (11 years old and younger). Kids 5 and younger are free. When making reservations, please let Natalie Tegio or Paula Featherstone know of any allergy information or special concerns. If cost is a concern, please see Pastor Kathy and we will work with you.


