Dear Friends,

I have a few things to share with you this month:

First, has anyone noticed there is tree in the Narthex? This amazing art installation is the creation of Jan Looney who is new to our church family. Currently the tree is bare and has icicles and snowflakes hanging from it, and there is some "snow" and fallen leaves gathered on the ground, reflecting the winter season that we are currently experiencing. As we move toward Lent and Spring, the tree will begin to thaw and we will begin to see life emerge from it. Service & Fellowship

Service Committee is off to a busy start. Starting February 6 and ending March 6, we will be collecting food donations for Northern Nevada Food Bank and Shared Harvest. Each Sunday we will be collecting specific food items.

- 2/6 Canned Meals Sunday: Stews, soup, spaghetti, ravioli, etc.
- 2/13 Protein Sunday: Peanut Butter, tuna, salmon, chicken, dried or canned beans.
- 2/20 Canned Fruit and Vegetable Sunday: (fruit - 100% juice or light syrup, 100% fruit juice boxes, vegetables - no or low salt).
- 2/27 Dairy and Grains Sunday: Shelf stable milk, whole grain cereal, oatmeal, brown rice, whole grain pasta.
- 3/6 Kids and Baby Sunday: Granola bars, popcorn, animal or graham crackers, baby formula, infant cereal, baby food.

Of course, any nonperishable food items will be accepted. Please check expiration dates. We cannot distribute anything that has expired.

During the months of April and May you will once again see chicks (with a suggested dollar donation) on our giving tree. The money collected will be sent to ELCA Good Gifts to purchase farm animals such as chicks. This donation to ELCA Good Gifts helps a family spread their wings. The animals not only provide an ongoing food supply but they can also help start a small business to generate a source of income.



Budget Challenge Campaign

Dear Holy Cross members and friends,

Our budget projection for 2022 utilizes the \$36,000 we have had in reserve since 2020. This money was a loan converted to a grant from the Federal Government for paycheck protection with the onset Covid. Despite scrubbing the expenses, no raises for 2022, and successful pledge campaign we are approximately \$7000 short.

One of our members has issued a budget challenge! This member will donate \$3,500 if the congregation will match another \$3,500 in additional giving. This would balance our budget for 2022 and give Holy Cross a year to continue our robust outreach/evangelism efforts.

We will close this challenge March 6, 2022.
