This year was our fourth year of doing Vacation Bible School at Holy Cross, and what's become a really special side benefit is to watch some of our youth who came as campers that first year or two grow as they have become helpers. We end up not just planting seeds in the children who attend, but we're also planting seeds of ministry skills and leadership in our youth. It really is a miraculous thing to see.

I want to thank you all for your help, your generosity, your donations, your prayers, your encouragement and your excitement as you have supported another year of our Vacation Bible School ministry. You are a blessing to me, to the church, to our children and our youth and I am so grateful for all of you.
