

## **Quilt Group News**

March 15 was National Quilting Day. Thank you to Pastor Kathy for her recognition of our Quilt Group's Work and the world wide work of Lutheran World Relief. Lutheran World Relief has been in "the quilt business" since 1945. This year we celebrate 80 years of helping our neighbors in need around the world.

Lutheran World Relief was founded in 1945 following World War II. Within the first three months of 1946, 2,260 bales of quilts, bedding and clothing were shipped to five countries in Europe. By March of 1946 there were an estimated 20,000 bales of bedding and clothing available and sent to war torn Europe from the LWR warehouse. This life saving ministry has grown significantly over the past 80 years. In 2024 LWR provided 371,000 quilts to 16 countries (including the United States). Holy Cross Quilters contributed 50 quilts to this effort. Holy Cross Quilters gave away over 300 quilts in 2024—most supporting people in need in our local community---9 local agencies, individuals and families.

In Luke 10, we are asked "who is my neighbor"? Our neighbor is anyone and everyone in need, no matter what. Our neighbor is whoever needs mercy, compassion and support. We are called to help. True, we can't help everyone, but Jesus isn't calling us to do that. God places the need on our hearts, in front of us, and calls us to respond with sacrificial love, our time, talents and resources. Empowered by the Holy Spirit, we care deeply, go out of our way to act to help those we can.

Holy Cross Quilters are blessed to part of this work of Lutheran World Relief—who for 80 years have put our faith in God into action by loving and serving our neighbors, no matter how near or far. For 80 years quilters throughout this country in Lutheran Congregations have shopped for supplies, scoured thrift stores, hunted for bargains, spent countless hours sewing, assemblying, tying and binding quilts.

For 80 years our combined love for others has been life-changing. Since 1945 our love has grown and expanded, reaching our neighbors whether they may be across the street or across the world. Thank you to all for sharing God's abundant love and compassion.


## **Buildings & Grounds**
